It's that time of year again: Please consider sharing your exciting profession with K-12 students by giving a presentation at a local school!

Engineer, Architect, and Land Surveyor (EALS) Week will take place February 18-25: Each year during EALS Week, SAME members and partners visit local elementary, middle and high schools to give exciting presentations that encourage students to consider engineering, architecture or land surveying as a career. We are seeking volunteers to conduct these presentations, and hope you will show your support!

We ask that you 1) give a short presentation (This could be an overview of your profession, what you do in your day-to-day, and/or anything else you think would get the students excited about STEM), and 2) conduct an engineering-themed, hands-on fun activity. The time frame is 45-90 minutes, depending on the school's preference and your availability.

Some volunteers are discouraged if they can't think of a good activity idea, but don't worry! You can find great ideas at the "STEM Activities - DiscoverE" website. SAME will also reimburse you up to \$30 per presentation for activity supplies. (Remember to keep your receipt!)

Below is a Google Form, which serves as our sign-up sheet. The form asks for your availability during EALS Week, which we will use to match you with a school that is requesting a presentation! We will reach back out to you to confirm a meeting date, time and location once we've matched you with a school. Please note that while 30-minute time blocks are listed on the form, presentations typically last 45-90 minutes depending on the school's preferences.

NOTE: If you are not available during EALS Week, but would like to conduct a presentation the week before or after, there is an opportunity on the form to sign up for that as well!
