Applications will be evaluated based on:

- 1 Grade point average
- 2 Internship/co-op experience and involvement in other activities
- 3 Two faculty recommendation(s)
- 4 Honors/scholarships/awards beginning in high school senior year
- 5 A 500 word (maximum) essay on applicant's "Engineering Career Goals & Aspirations to Achieve Them"

c. Required Application Materials

Applications must include the following:

- 1 NSPE Member or Student Membership number
- 2 A transcript
- 3 A resume or summary of internship/co-op experience(s) and involvement in other activities
- 4 Recommendations from two faculty members
- 5 A 500 word (maximum) essay on applicant's "Engineering Career Goals & Aspirations to Achieve Them"

d. Other

- All applicants will be notified of the final selection by July 10th of each year.
- The Fellowship award will be disbursed to the recipient's school in one installment for the next fall semester.
- Upon completion of the graduate degree, the winner will be required to submit to the NSPE Educational Foundation Trustees a report on the value of the NSPE support and their objectives regarding professional development, ethical practice, and licensure.
